Situated at a mountain region, has the perfect weather to grow coffee, Pinhal is a highlight of fine coffees, which are searched by the most critical importers.



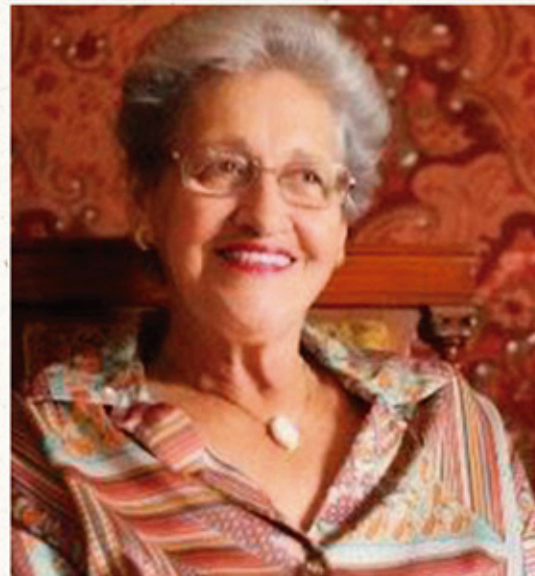
NOVA UNIÃO FARM

ABOUT THE FARM:

The farm has been with the family for over 60 years. On the property are cultivated the coffee varieties Obatã, Mundo Novo and Catuaí. An average of 600 bags are collected annually, all of which are manually harvested.

The owner, Laura Luiza Del Guerra Vergueiro, is proud to have won the highest grade in the 12th Concurso Estadual de Qualidade do Café de São Paulo - Aldir Alves Teixeira Award, which had the cupping events held on October 23 and 24, 2013.

On the property, the owner relies on her family's collaboration to manage the farm so they can produce better and better coffees each year.
